Today is the oldest you have ever been and the youngest you will ever be. Is today the day you will decide to serve on a medical mission team?

Have you ever wondered who the people are who join Health Teams International's medical mission teams? Do you think that you must be a healthcare professional to join one of our teams? Do you have the impression that our mission trips are all work and no play? Do you have the impression that it is so expensive that you cannot afford to take up the challenge? Well, here are some answers to these questions:

In addition to medical doctors, dentists, dental hygienists, dental assistants, nurses, and optical workers, we use the services of pharmacists, jack-of-all-trades volunteers, evangelistic workers, and specialty youth workers like Youth With a Mission. We have even had veterinarians with us in Mongolia and Benin. Our ages have ranged from 14 (a daughter assisting her dentist/dad) to several 75-year-olds.

Because many of our mission trips are to some very interesting countries around the world and most of our teams members give up their annual vacation to join us, our team leaders take the opportunity to be "tourists" for two or three days at the end of the mission, visiting sites like The Great Wall of China, the Taj Mahal, Machu Picchu.

It is not too costly to accompany us on a mission trip. Costs range from \$2,500 to \$3,100 and include all expenses—travel, accommodations, and meals.

Do you have to be a citizen of Canada or the US to join a certain team? No, because HTI Canada and the U. S. work in partnership with each other, filling our teams with members of each other's volunteer database.



DR. DALE AND MARY ANN LOUIS IN LIBERIA

Dr. Dale and Mary Ann, HTI Board members from Colorado, recently returned from their longest-ever dental mission trip to Liberia where they served more than 1,500 people. Liberia is in need of more healthcare attention due to the prevalence of diabetes, malaria, parasitic worms, hypertension, and a variety of infections. Their report told of dental patients with large tumors that required a hospital setting for removal. In one instance, a man came in carrying his hernia in his two hands. For a week, they worked deep into the interior of the country working in rural villages and towns. In the process of rebuilding because of the brutal civil war that had occurred, it leads the way in being among the poorest and neediest places in Africa. They felt that their time in Liberia was very special and are contemplating returning again next year. There are so many more needs to be met.
